



Identifying and Responding to Opioid Abuse in the Community Pharmacy

A CPhA On-Demand Webinar

This webinar is intended to broaden the existing skills of community pharmacists in recognizing and responding to opioid abuse. The webinar will include background on the growing opioid epidemic in the United States and efforts to reduce mortality related to any opioid use. This includes dosing recommendations, tools to identify opioid abuse, increased access to substance abuse services and take-home naloxone. Important information for community pharmacists will include opioid safety counseling for all opioid prescriptions, responding to newly identified opioid abuse, language to maintain patient engagement and counseling patients on how to recognize and respond to an opioid overdose with take-home naloxone.

- Identify risk factors for opioid use disorder in chronic pain patients
- Modify patient counseling for opioid prescriptions to include elements of opioid safety
- Develop a screening plan for opioid abuse in a community pharmacy

- Outline a referral process to evidence-based substance abuse treatment from a community pharmacy
- Effectively counsel a patient on recognizing and responding to an opioid overdose with take-home naloxone
