At CPhA's past in-person Advocacy Days, you had the opportunity to meet with a legislator or their staff to discuss many of our sponsored bills or legislation affecting the profession. **This year we are bringing the legislative appointments to you virtually!**

### **Legislative Appointments:**

Each attendee registered by April 7 will have the chance to be an advocate for their profession! You will be assigned a meeting with a legislator's office, and CPhA will provide training and talking points to prepare you. This is a critical time to show lawmakers how important pharmacists are for the success of the healthcare team and the public health benefit they continue to provide to the community during a pandemic.

### **Part of CPhA's Sponsored Legislation:**

#### **AB 671 (Wood) – Medi-Cal: pharmacy benefits**

AB 671 is a reintroduction of AB 2100 from last year. This bill authorizes the Department of Healthcare Services to provide a disease management or similar payment to a pharmacy that the department has contracted with to

#### **AB 524 (Fong) - Pharmacy practice: Vaccines**

The bill would authorize pharmacists to administer all FDA approved vaccinations for California residents 3 years and older. Current law only allows pharmacists to provide routine immunization schedule recommended by the federal Advisory

dispense a specialty drug to Medi-Cal beneficiaries in an amount necessary to ensure beneficiary access.

Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP), in compliance with individual ACIP vaccine recommendations, and public by the federal Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for persons three years of age or older.
